

Thomas F. Goss Biography

Thomas Goss has more than 20 years of experience managing and directing healthcare research, including the impact of public and private payer policy on patient access, health-related quality-of-life, patient preference, patient satisfaction, and health economic evaluations. He also directs disease management program evaluations using patient outcomes data. He has published extensively in these areas and has more than 40 peer-reviewed publications and over 75 peer-reviewed abstracts and invited publications. Prior to joining Boston Healthcare Associates, Dr. Goss was Vice President and Director of Consulting Services at Covance Market Access Services, where he had a 15-year career with increasing levels of responsibility in the areas of client management and executive management. Dr. Goss received a Pharm.D. from the State University of New York at Buffalo, and a B.S. from the Albany College of Pharmacy. He completed graduate course work in Epidemiology, and a postdoctoral fellowship in Pharmacoepidemiology and Outcomes Research at the State University of New York at Buffalo.
