Dr Roser Pons is a graduate of the Pediatric Neurology training program at Columbia Presbyterian Medical Center, New York. Prior to that, she had several years of training in the genetics and biochemistry of mitochondrial and fatty acid oxidation disorders that manifest with neuromuscular and cerebral syndromes. Subsequent to her residency, she underwent further training in the subspecialty of Movement disorders at Columbia University. She is mainly interested in the diagnosis and management of rare neurological conditions of childhood that manifest themselves through abnormalities of motor function and motor control.

Currently she is working in the First University Clinic at Children's Hospital Agia Sofia in Athens where she is the responsible for the Special Unit of Pediatric Neurology. She runs several outpatient clinics including "Movement disorders and Rare Neurological Disorders", "Neurocutaneous disorders" and "Dystonia Clinic"
